OLYMPIAD INFORMATION 2021 *Educators and Olympiad organisers

Proverto has organised National Olympiads since 2011 with great success.

As an organiser we envisage to improve the Olympiads by implementing suggestions and recommendations from educators through surveys and interviews. Proverto has realised the need for syllabus based Olympiads and introduced The Proverto National High School Olympiad in 2019. A total of 18 Olympiad Exam Papers were compiled in both English and Afrikaans (CAPS) The 2019/2020 syllabus based olympiad was a huge success. The 3-in-1 Olympiad consists of the following 3 subjects, available in Afrikaans and English:

1. One Paper: Grade 10, 3 Subjects. Accounting, Business Studies, Economics (English, Grade 10) Rekeningkunde, Besigheidstudies, Ekonomie (Afrikaans Graad 10)

- 2. One Paper: Grade 11, 3 Subjects. Accounting, Business Studies, Economics (English, Grade 11) Rekeningkunde. Besigheidstudies, Ekonomie (Afrikaans Graad 11)
- 3. One Paper: Grade 12, 3 Subjects. Accounting, Business Studies, Economics (English, Grade 12)
- 4. One Paper: UJFIMO, Optional Quiz Grade 10 12

There will be ONE Exam Paper per grade, consisting of Olympiad Papers developed per subject, per grade.

Dates & Olympiad Entry Fees:

Final closing date: 15 April at R120 per learner (both rounds)
Early bird entry fee deadline: 15 March at R 100 per learner (both rounds)

There is no limit to the total number of entries per school.

Exam Papers, Dates, & Delivery:

1. The Olympiad will consist of two rounds and all subjects will be written on the same day.

Learners may complete UJFIMO at no additional cost and it is optional.

- 2. A scope of work will be emailed to the educator and will also be available on the Proverto Website.
- 3. Learners will have the option to write both the papers online or at school.
- 4. Round one will be written on **12 May 2021**
- 5. Round two (final round) will be written on 4th August 2021
- 6. Proverto will notify all learners who have qualified to participate in the second round.

7. The Olympiad exam papers (pdf format) and online links will be emailed to teachers one day before the test. If the learners choose to write online they can submit their answers electronically. If the teacher prefers that the learners write the test at school teachers may print the exam and answer sheets, scan and email the completed answer sheets to Proverto, the organiser.

Educators & Communication:

All educators, HOD's, Principals or Olympiad organisers at schools may participate to enter their class or classes for Gr 10 -12 in three subjects, available in Afrikaans and English: Accounting, Business Studies and Economics + UJFIMO free quiz, Finance and Investment Proverto, the organiser of the Olympiad will be in contact with the educator(s) or olympiad organisers providing all information needed throughout the year. Prizes and Participation Certificates:

The Olympiad was a huge success and a total amount of R 300 000 in prizes for schools, educators and winners were allocated in 2020. There will be great prizes and bursaries awarded to the winners in 2021 as well as cash prizes and promotional gifts from Proverto & sponsors! More details will be available closer to the final round.

The second and final round will determine the overall winners of the Olympiad. There will also be winners selected for UJFIMO. Winners will be selected in each subject, Accounting, Business Studies and Economics per grade.

All participating schools, learners, educators and facilitators will receive an e-certificate for participation when completing the Olympiad. All participating learners, schools and educators will receive certificates from UJFIMO, The University of Johannesburg.

Code of Conduct and Ethics for Teachers/Invigilators

- 1. Teachers/Invigilators to report to the examination venue at least 30 minutes before the commencement of the examination.
- 2. Candidates are to be admitted to the examination venue and to be seated at least 15 minutes before commencement of the examination.
- 3. Teachers/Invigilators to ensure that all candidates have received their examination question papers and answer booklets before the commencement of the examination at the time scheduled. (online or offline)
- 4. Teachers/Invigilators to ensure all scripts are collected once the examination has been written no candidate is to be allowed to leave the venue with his/ her script.
- 5. No candidates are permitted to enter the examination venue, after 1 hour from the commencement of the examination.
- 6. No candidate may leave the examination venue during the last 15 minutes of the examination. Candidates who leave the venue and intend returning to continue writing, are to be accompanied by an invigilator whilst outside the examination venue.
- 7. When there are queries from the candidates, relating to the exam, Teachers/Invigilators are under no circumstances allowed to render any explanation pertaining to the answer to the candidates.
- 8. If a candidate requires assistance from the Teacher/Invigilator, he/ she is to raise their hand. If this is not observed, the candidate is to stand up.
- 9. Candidates are only to have possession of their stationery, calculators, the examination paper and answer sheet whilst in the examination venue. All bags, books & other articles are to be left outside of the examination venue.
- 10. The use of cellular telephones is strictly to be used to write online during the course of the examination if the educator registered for the olympiad online option.
- 11. The use of audio devices (such as MP3 players/ iPods) are strictly prohibited during the course of the examination.
- 12. Teachers/Invigilators are to check that all material relating to an examination are removed from the walls and chalkboard of the classroom prior to the exam.
- 13. Candidates are to be seated at least 1 metre apart.
- 14. Teachers/Invigilators are to ensure all examination paper deliveries are free from tampering in any way, and delivered sealed and clearly marked. Any evidence of prior tampering is to immediately be brought to the Institute's attention.
- 15. Candidates who have been found to be contravening the examination rules , must have their scripts immediately removed.
- 16. On collection of scripts the Teacher/Invigilator is to check the candidate's name is clearly indicated on the cover of the script, before accepting.
- 17. Scan, email of answer sheets and olympiad exam papers to be treated as highly confidential
